Available COVID-19 Information

Both COVID-19 test results and vaccination information are available in ConnectingOntario ClinicalViewer to authorized health care practitioners and organizations. For this information to display in the ClinicalViewer, the following conditions must be met:

- patient must have a valid Ontario Health Card Number
- patient must not have blocked the display of their medications, lab results or COVID-19 information
- required data repository must be available
- COVID-19 testing facility must contribute results to Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS)

If any of these conditions are not met, COVID-19 information will not display in the ClinicalViewer. This does not necessarily mean that the patient has not been tested or vaccinated.

COVID-19 information displays in two portlets as explained below.

COVID-19 Test Results Display in the Lab and Pathology Results Portlet

To view COVID-19 test results:

- 1. Adjust the timeline as required
- In the Lab and Pathology Results portlet, select Expand OR

On the Navigation bar, select Lab/Pathology Results

COVID-19 Test and Vaccination Information Display in the Medications Portlet

Health care practitioners document the administration of COVID-19 vaccinations in the COVID-19 Vaccine Global Access Facility, Ontario ($COVax_{ON}$). The Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR) provides a subset of this information in near real-time to the ClinicalViewer.

COVID-19 vaccination information displays as a drug rather than as a professional service (as is the case for flu vaccination information). COVID-19 test information displays in the Medications portlet only when a pharmacy performs the test and does not include test results. Consult the Lab and Pathology Results portlet for the test results.

Notes

- COVID-19 vaccination information may not be available due to either slow application response or temporary unavailability. Refreshing the ClinicalViewer (
) may result in successfully retrieving and displaying the information. Be aware that the absence of vaccine information does not necessarily mean the patient has not been vaccinated.
- 2. Existing DHDR consent directives and processes remain the same and apply to $COVax_{ON}$ records:
 - If a patient has blocked access to their DHDR records and a COVID-19 vaccination record is available for that patient, the COVax_{ON} record will also be blocked
 - When a patient/substitute decision maker's consent and signature are obtained and a temporary consent override is performed, all available DHDR and COVax_{ON} information is unblocked

However, at the time of COVID-19 vaccination, if a patient does not consent to share their information, it is not entered into $COVax_{ON}$. Therefore, a record of the vaccination is <u>not</u> available in $COVax_{ON}$ or DHDR.
